SUMMER DATA WORKSHOP

Using the Panel Component of IPUMS CPS

June 4-6, 2018

IPUMS is accepting applications for the **IPUMS CPS Summer Data Workshop** at the Minnesota Population Center on the University of Minnesota campus in Minneapolis, MN. The workshop will familiarize researchers with the under-utilized panel component of the **Current Population Survey (CPS)**. The CPS is an ongoing labor force survey in the U.S. Data are available annually back to 1962 with monthly data available since 1976.

The 2018 IPUMS CPS Workshop is targeted toward graduate students, postdoctoral fellows and early-career faculty from social science disciplines. The workshop will include presentations from the research team that developed IPUMS CPS and other experienced CPS researchers, lab sessions that provide hands-on experience with using the CPS as a longitudinal dataset, and small-group sessions where participants will discuss their own CPS research ideas with others who have similar interests.

Applications are due March 2, 2018. Applicants should submit:

- Information about their professional backgrounds
- A short statement regarding their interest in using the panel component of the CPS
- A letter of support from an advisor or senior colleague

Up to \$1,000 in expenses for the workshop will be covered; eligible expenses include domestic air fares, local transportation costs, and hotel accommodations.
